Our home is not a tourist attraction, but we'd like to give you the opportunity to experience life in rural Kenya and see the difference we have been able to make in the children's lives.

The day is informal and unstructured. You will be collected from your hotel at around 10am and driven the one hour journey up into the rural Shimba Hills. Kerry will show you around the home and on school days you can see the children at school. Footprints will serve a simple, traditional lunch and the afternoon can be spent playing with the children.



All we ask is for a donation of 2,500 Kenyan Shillings (approx £20) per person to cover the cost of transport and food and a contribution to our home. If you wish to make a further donation, the most beneficial thing to bring is quite simply food, as this is our biggest outlay by far. Kerry will be happy to stop at the supermarket near your hotel, or the wholesalers in the nearby town of Ukunda on your journey to Footprints Orphanage.

Other useful items are; boys and girls clothing for ages 4-17 years, educational materials such as books and games (we are fortunate that we have already been given a large number of pencils & crayons) or a football.
